

Prescription Medication Guide and Log

Motrin (Ibuprofen) is a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory that helps **decrease pain and swelling**. Take regularly for the first 3 days in 6-hour intervals. Do not take on an empty stomach.

Norco (Hydrocodone + tylenol) is a narcotic that helps **decrease severe pain**. Take it as needed but may be required regularly at least the first 2 days. A good strategy is to alternate with Motrin. Do not drive or make important decisions on this medication as it will make you drowsy.

Prednisone is a steroid that helps **decrease swelling**. <u>It should be taken 30 minutes after Motrin to prevent stomach</u> problems.

Amoxicillin is an antibiotic that helps prevent infection

Day 1 (Day of surgery) - ice packs to face <u>Time:</u>
□ (When you get home): Amoxicillin, Prednisone
□ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (6 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (12 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (At bedtime): Motrin, Prednisone (30 minutes later), Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
Day 2 - start salt-water rinses, Peridex and ice packs to face <u>Time:</u>
□ (When you wake up): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (6 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (12 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (At bedtime): Motrin, Prednisone (30 minutes later), Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
Day 3 - warm compresses to face Time:
□ (When you wake up): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (6 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin, Prednisone (30 minutes later)
□ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol
□ (12 hours): Motrin, Amoxicillin
□ (At bedtime): Motrin, Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol

Days 4+ Continue the Amoxicillin three times daily until finished, Motrin and/or Norco as needed for pain.

<u>Prednisone</u> is a steroid that helps **decrease swelling**. <u>It should be taken 30 minutes after Motrin to prevent stomach problems.</u>

<u>Peridex</u> (chlorhexidine) mouth wash is an antimicrobial that helps prevent infection. Swish for 30 seconds and let solution drool out of your mouth (do not spit forcefully).

Day 1 (Day of surgery) - Ice packs to face Time: □ ____ (When you get home): Start with Prednisone □ ____ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ _____ (6 hours): Motrin, <u>Prednisone</u>, 30 minutes later □ ____ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ ____ (12 hours): Motrin, Prednisone, 30 minutes later □ _____ (At bedtime): Motrin, Prednisone, 30 minutes later, Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol Day 2 - Start salt-water and Peridex rinses, ice packs to face [When you wake up] Motrin, Prednisone, 30 minutes later, Peridex mouth wash □ ____ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ ____ (6 hours): Motrin, <u>Prednisone</u>, 30 minutes later □ ____ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ _____ (12 hours): Motrin, <u>Prednisone</u>, <u>30 minutes later</u>, Peridex mouth wash [At bedtime]: Motrin, Prednisone 30 minutes later, Norco OR Tylenol Day 3 - warm compresses to face [(When you wake up) Motrin, Prednisone, 30 minutes later, Peridex mouth wash □ ____ (3 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ ____ (6 hours): Motrin, Prednisone, 30 minutes later □ ____ (9 hours): Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol □ ____ (12 hours): Motrin, Peridex mouth wash ☐ _____ (At bedtime): Motrin, Norco <u>OR</u> Tylenol

Days 4+ Take Motrin and/or Norco as needed for pain and continue Peridex until sites are healed completely (1 month)
